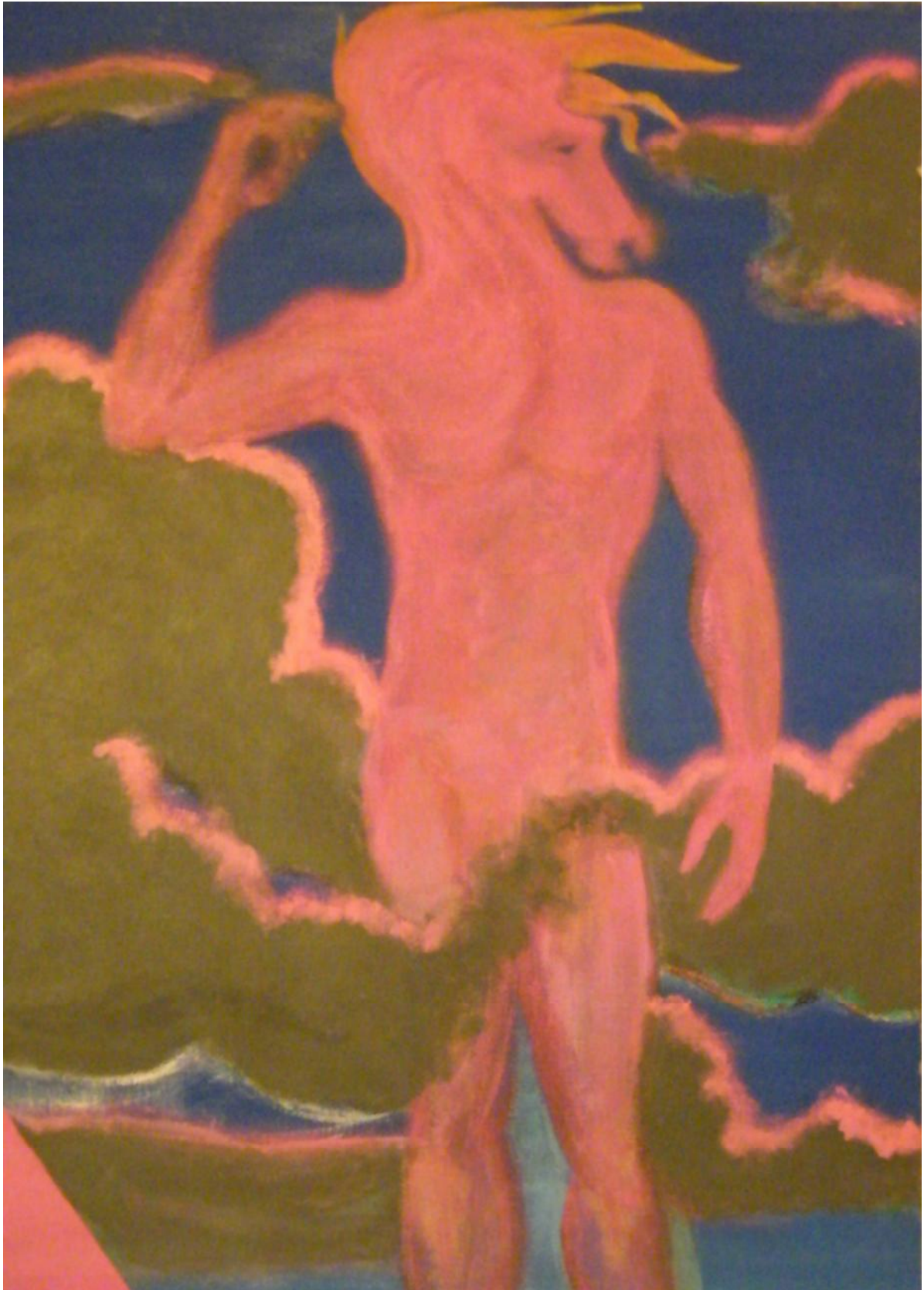

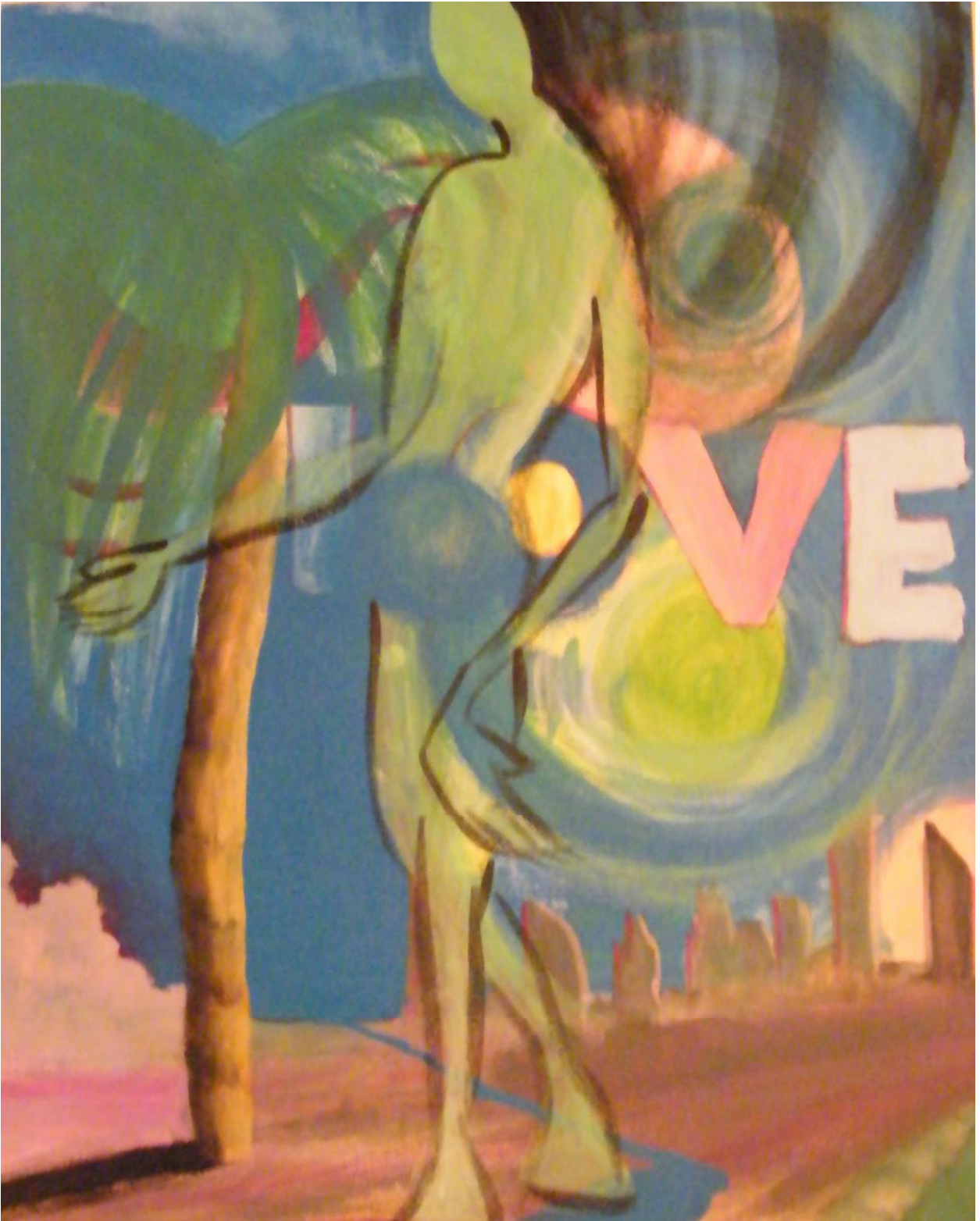

JEFFREY W. PERGAMENT, 1951 –

The images presented in this document represent some of my current inventory of finished paintings now available for sale and/or exhibition. The size range averages from 16" x 20" to 30" x 40" and all works are acrylic pigment. Some are mixed media with photographs (collaged) and graphite.

I have been a practicing professional visual artist since 1974 and I received my VA in Media Studies in December, 1974. My senior show included photographs, paintings and films. My first group show was in 1974 at Gallery Reese Palley at The Shelburne, Park Place and the Boardwalk, with Salvador Dali and Pablo Picasso. My most recent exhibit was a group show at The Newman Galleries on Walnut Street in Philadelphia during the summer of 2009. In 2010, I contracted a lung infection and was rushed to the ER to save my life. Emergency lung surgery and intense antibiotic ICU saved my life yet during my term in ICU, I suffered a heart attack and then had heart surgery and a stent was installed in my right coronary artery to open the blocked artery.

This past June, I returned to my easel and started to paint again. I learned in late August that my only daughter had died in June. I started a piece on her birthday – June 6, 2011 and she died in June 18, 2011. She was 37 years of age. The following is this current work in progress:
